3RD ANNUAL REPORT

The club has now been operating for three seasons, commencing in season 1967-68 with one team in "B" grade matting of the Eastern Suburbs Cricket Association.

In this our third year the club fielded two sides for the first time. The first eleven played in the "A" grade competition and the second eleven in their first season played in the "C" grade.

Season 1969-70

The first match of the season for the first eleven resulted in their usual drubbing, however, over the rest of the season only four more matches were lost and the team finished in fifth position. Overall this was a solid performance but not indicative of the true skill in the team.

The second eleven won four of their ten games and finished ninth out of fourteen teams. The pleasing factor in this was the great enthusiasm of the team and increased skill and experience apparent towards the end of the season.

Finance

The costs of running the club were once again very heavy due primarily to the establishment of a second eleven and the need to buy additional equipment. The costs in running the club can be seen in that \$792.00 passed through the club books this year. The Treasurer's report which is attached is a compliment to all involved.

Supporters

It is a pleasure to once again record that S.T.C. can boast a relatively large loyal and keen group of supporters.

Our appreciation goes to the lady supporters who without exception, provided afternoon tea at all home matches. The value of this is seen in the goodwill it helps to promote with the opposing teams. Our special thanks is extended to these ladies.

Outstanding Performances

During the season three of the senior members of the club achieved milestones in careers with S.T.C. Both Denis Harrison and Peter Sandilands have now taken over 100 wickets

for the club. Alan Yarwood is the first batsman in the club to top 1000 runs. Congratulations to these three fine clubmen.

It should also be mentioned here that the club itself has an unblemished record with the Association in that we have not had one fine in our three years in A.S.C.A. This reflects great credit on the players in the club and the Committee wishes to thank everyone for their efforts in this regard, and hope that the same efforts will be made in the future.
