TWELTH ANNUAL REPORT AND FINANCIAL STATEMENT.

On behalf of the Committee of S.T.C. Cricket Club, I present the Twelfth Annual Report and Financial Statement for season 78/79.

S.T.C. once again fielded Three Senior Teams in the 'A', 'B' & 'E' Matting Grades of E.S.C.A. The E Grade Matting side showed what it is all about when they carried off the Premiership giving the club its second consecutive premiership.

There were many fine performances during the season as the following summaries will show:

1ST XI

Led by Peter Sandilands the Firsts won 5 lost 5, drew 2. It should be noted that in both drawn games S.T.C. was in a position from which they could have gained full points and finished closer than the 6th position indicates.

John made 57, Tim 53n.o.

It was a fitting result to a team which had worked hard during the year for the victory and who gave their captain anything and everything he asked for.
