## JUNIOR CO-ORDINATOR'S REPORT

The 1996/97 season was a successful one at junior level for STC. The Under-14 Reds were rewarded for a brilliant season by winning the Mitchell Shield. The boys went through the season undefeated and put in some incredible performances throughout the year.

Premierships are not the only way to measure success. In context, all five junior sides had successful seasons. The Under-16s and the Under-14 Blues had similar fortunes. Both won their share of games, but two or three narrow losses each put the finals out of reach. On their day, both teams showed they could match it with the top sides.

Wins were harder to come by at Under-12 level, but both the Reds and Blues took huge leaps throughout the year. The Reds struggled early in the season, but showed steady improvement with each game. This culminated in their dramatic (and now legendary) one run victory in the last game. The Blue team was unable to break through for a win, but this is not the point. The side was largely made up of eight and nine year olds who had never played before - all of whom will benefit from this season's experience. It would not surprise me at all to see players from these two sides play in premierships for STC in future years.

Looking ahead, the numbers for next season are interesting. Based on those who played this year, next year we will have 21 Under-12s, 13 Under-14s, and 28 Under-16s. Unless some recruiting is done at Under-14 level it may only be possible to field one side. I believe it is important to field Friday & Saturday teams in this age-group to ensure that more players are able to play.

The smooth running of the junior teams this season was due to four individuals in particular: Anthony Purcell, named Coach of the Year for his efforts in managing **two** sides throughout the season (Under-16s and Under-12 Blues) as well as running training each week; Dan Muling, the premiership team manager with the Under-14 Reds; Max Giblett, a great team manager over several seasons at STC, looked after the Under-14 Blues; and Chris Shinnars, who moulded the Under-12 Reds into a force to be reckoned with. All four guys deserve congratulations on the jobs they did this season.

Others who provided invaluable help were Greg Spithill, Malcolm Simister and Stuart Anderson, who all stepped in to manage teams when required, and Basil Finnegan, who ran training with Purcy each week.

### Report on the Fighting 4th Eleven

In 1996/97, the 4th Eleven were promoted to C Grade following our good effort in reaching the finals the previous year. Despite the loss of our champion batsman (Nick Oddy) and bowler (Leigh Jondahl) the team had another enjoyable year. The year started with a thrilling tie against Kooyong. Defending a total of 122, and with Kooyong at 6 for 115, Andy Daly took 3 for 2 and yours truly ran out the last batsman with a direct hit in the 39th over to tie the game. Needless to say, Kooyong were speechless. This was followed with an outright win over the hapless Glen Iris with Kev Burt making 137 and Don D'Cruz 45 in a 146 run partnership to set up the win: Chris McNeill took 6 wickets for the game. A loss to Mulgrave (Maskiell 52) was followed by a win over Kerrimuir with Andy Daly (65) and Ryan Chard (22 no) putting on 80 for the last wicket and Martin Lynch hitting his highest score for the club (37): Kev Burt then took 6 for 11 off 8.3 overs to win the game. Unbelievable win but it goes to show miracles do happen. Chasing 262 against E Doncaster, STC made 5 for 272 with Kev Burt making a fine 83 no and, with Army Maskiell (43), Peter Sandilands (41) and Ranj Singh (33 no), set up the win.

After Christmas, we struggled to win a 2 day game. A poor loss to E Malvern was followed by a great 1 day game in the heat at E Malvern with Kev Burt (86) and Andy Curry (56) setting up a win, only to see us lose the points due to a non registered player. Losses to Mt Waverley and Bulleen (D'Cruz 77, Dom Sandilands 49, his highest score for the club) followed. A 1 day win over N Balwyn saw Kev Burt (44 no) and Aaron Tracey (44 no) win the game. The last game was a disappointing loss to N Balwyn with Kev Burt (67) and Aaron Tracey (60) leading a fight back.

The year was highlighted by the excellent individual efforts of Kevin Burt who made 524 runs at 47.6 and took 20 wickets at 24.6 to clearly win the team champion trophy. Well done Kev. Andy Daly showed further improvement as a bowler to take the bowling trophy (17 wickets at 22.0). Don D'Cruz took the batting trophy (194 runs at 27.7). Other good contributions came from Army Maskiell (191 runs at 21.2), Dom Sandilands (127 runs at 25.4) and Marty Lynch (9 catches, 9 wickets).

In the end, the 4th Eleven performed well winning 37 points in a higher Grade and we should be pleased with our overall effort. Our weakness was our inability to bowl teams out when we were in a position to win the game. Hopefully, the Club will address this at the selection table and by recruiting another strike bowler to support Andy Daly and Ranj Singh.
