secretary's report

1999/2000 proved to be an exceptional season for STC off the field. The club was able to build on the strong position in which it finished the previous season, and capitalize on the forward momentum.

The club grew for the first time in its history to incorporate a fifth senior team, took tenancy of a third playing oval, purchased a significant amount of new infrastructure, and still posted a healthy profit. Indeed the purchase of a bowling machine (for the first time ever), a new industrial barbecue, and new synthetic mats, is an investment which should hold the club in good stead for many years to come.

The strong profit that the club was able to post is proof of the financial viability of STC, and the will of the committee and members to dig deep and make the club a success. The massive efforts of the committee in the past two years, particularly Richard Corbett, in the area fund raising have been generously met by the club members and wider STC community. Indeed it is the efforts in areas such as this that underpin the financial success of the club in recent years.

From an administrative perspective the club has been able to nurture a healthy relationship with both the works department at the City of Boroondara, and the Eastern Cricket Association. Recent improvements in the quality of the batting nets, and minor ground improvements on Nettleton Park West, are testimony of our ability to work with Council. However, it is this area which will throw the greatest challenges in the next few years. As a club we must do all in our power to improve facilities at Nettleton, and ultimately find a new more suitable home for the senior STC team.

The relatively low number of fines which we were forced to pay this season is testimony to the efficiency of both the committee and the captains. While certain aspects of administration requires greater diligence on behalf of club office bearers, we can all be relatively pleased with the standard of administration last year. It will be the responsibility of the new committee to ensure that all fines are avoided if possible, because club money is better spent on cricket equipment.

One the challenges the incoming committee will face is the position it will take in relation to the proposed restructure of Metropolitan Cricket. The VCA has proposed a total restructure of metropolitan cricket, based not on traditional associations, but on municipal boundaries. Such a restructure would fundamentally disturb the fabric of eastern suburbs cricket. This move would not only destroy traditional aspects of cricket, but the lengthy and complete regarding process would hamper progress of clubs such as ours.

The committee this year framed our opposition to the VCA restructure, however it is the responsibility of the incoming committee to reinvestigate this situation. To lend support, even passive support, to this restructure would be to act outside the best interests of the club.

I would like to conclude by thanking all members for their support this season, and point out that it is the hard work of the President and the committee that ensures that the club is in such good shape.

junior co-ordinator's report

I picked up the task of Junior Co-ordinator in October after returning from family holidays. I would like to open this report by thanking those Committee members, especially Rick Corbett, James Hall and Daniel Shacklock, whose efforts leading up to the season ensured that STC was able to field four junior teams in season 1999/2000.

We entered two teams in under 12s, one in Under 14s and one in Under 16s. In terms of match results, the season was a modest one, but the boys enjoyed their cricket and showed considerable improvement through the season. The Under 12 Blues may have recorded only one victory, in their final match, but no-one could doubt the elation of the boys as they marched triumphantly off the ground singing the club song.

Dan Muling and Tim Bach (whose impeccable work over previous seasons as Junior Co-ordinator made it easier and more daunting to take on the responsibility of the position) managed the Under 16s admirably. Like the Under 14s, the team played its games on Friday nights after daylight saving started, and suffered from unfavorable weather that disrupted several games. One memorable wash-out at Nettleton was only confirmed by the time the light was failing anyway, and led to an objection from our visitors, which was dismissed with scant ceremony by the ECA Junior Executive. The team finished equal ninth on the ladder, with 30 points for the season.

The Under 14s showed great promise, with many of the boys in their first season out of Under 12s. Several new recruits boosted the side, which benefited from Graham Johnston's excellent management. The team showed promise of even better things to come, with some fine performances late in the season, and an outside chance of reaching the finals with a couple of games to go. The side finished seventh, with 30 points.

The Under 12 Reds suffered from not having a regular manager, and were looked after by a succession of Committee members, in conjunction with frequent Saturday morning sprints from Mt Martha by Basil Finnigan. Both Under 12 sides struggled for numbers, with 22 players on the list by the end of the season, but rarely more than eighteen available to be split between the two sides. All the same, the Reds finished ninth on their ladder with 38 points. The Blues, as noted above, had to wait a long time for their first win, but finished equal eighth on their ladder with 35 points. The team gave many of the boys their first taste of competitive sport, and the improvement from week to week and the steady development of a genuine team spirit demonstrated clearly the benefits of commitment to a team sport.

The season also included a couple of Sunday morning junior clinics, which attracted disappointing attendance numbers but gave the boys who came along the chance to hone their skills with one on one tuition from senior players. February saw the annual parents and sons games, with the U12Reds taking on the Blues and the U14s and U16s combining to tackle the parents. The Junior Presentation Night in March was extremely well attended by the boys and their families and allowed all the players to celebrate the success of participating, as well as recognising the special efforts of the trophy-winners.

Special thanks are due to all the managers, Committee members, senior players who helped with the special events as well as those who turned up on dewy Saturday mornings when rostered, and the parents who helped with transport, scoring, the canteen and the dozens of other tasks that go with junior sport. Very special thanks go to Basil Finnigan who gave up so much time to coach the Under 12s on Wednesday afternoons, and to Peter Lynch who gave Basil fantastic support. I look forward to all the boys coming back and building on their skills in season 2000/01, and an even better commitment from the senior part of the Club to the juniors who represent the long-term future of STC.

The stand-out bowler for the season was Matthew 'Spider' Funnell, who in his first year at STC claimed 40 wickets, only 5 behind the record for the two's, and whose consistency in keeping the 'aggot' on a good line and length was his trademark. He received tremendous support from James 'Magic' Hall (25 wkts), Daniel 'Sugar' Shacklock (17 wkts), Mark 'Molly' Molloy (14 wkts) and Adam 'A.B.' Blight (14 wkts).

Finally, I would like to thank my teammates for their contributions and support throughout the year, Kevin Burt for his efforts as Chairman of Selectors, Simon 'Smacka' McCarthy for those magnificent afternoon teas and to all members and supporters of the STC Cricket Club.

fourth eleven captain's report

The Fours had a consistent and competitive year finishing in 2nd spot with 63 points. After the loss of several classy players from last year's Grand Final team, it was a new team that stepped out in C grade against Richmond Union losing by 1 run in the last over of the day with their score at 9/134 (Rowe 5/35). A narrow loss to Deepdene (Nicholson 68 and 4/24, Burt 56) was followed by a big win against our old rivals E Doncaster (160 and 6/167) (STC 289: Sandilands 64; 4/39 and 2/42; Banks Smith 41). Good wins followed against N Balwyn (Pivetta 3/13 and 3/22, a near hat trick-sorry, Mick!, and 39), Manningham (157) (Nicholson 4/54 and 47; Burt 47) and N Balwyn (Fahey 4/55, Spithill 57 no, Pivetta 61). The Boronia game saw Marty cop one in the head but came back to make 72 no with Sandilands 38, Burt 60 and Rowe 38 helping us reach 8/289 (Boronia 143). Another win against Boronia (187; Allen 2 catches, 2 run outs)(Rowe 63, K Lynch 32 no) was followed by a great win over E Doncaster (204, Chard 3/14) where P Docherty made a terrific come back 107 no to get us over the line despite the verballing.

In the second half of the season competition for places in the four were very competitive with essentially a win required in every game to ensure a finals spot. We lost to Richmond (8/412, STC 298: Kimber 63 a great effort, Pivetta 46, Spithill 43) then had a terrific win over Manningham (188; STC 9/269; Pivetta 4/39, Spithill 76, M Lynch 44, Pivetta 41) with Peter Morrison (3/20) emerging as a potential match winner as he bamboozled their big hitter. The next match at STC was a must win: we made 263 (Docherty 63, Spithill 59) and Deepdene had us struggling at 3/144 at tea before some brilliant catching by Tom Sandy (2 blinders) and fine bowling by Marty (3/53), Sterling (3/49) and Peter (3/64) saw them all out for 250. It was one of our best wins. The last game was against Burwood and what a match. They were very aggro and their captain could not control the head cases. Pat Doch (151) and Mick (116) took a verballing all day but each made centuries, pasting them all over the ground, and put on 265 for the third wicket as we made 6/429 (K Lynch 36). After struggling early, we got Burwood for 290 (M Lynch 4/97, Pivetta 3/32) and prepared to face them next week in the Semi.

The Semi Final against Burwood was a huge disappointment. We lost the toss and they batted well for 298 (P Morrison 3/48, M Lynch 3/88), with some fine team catching, good keeping in the heat by Ben and tight bowling holding them to only 65 runs off the last 20 overs. We then proceeded to put in our worst batting effort for the year being 4/14 (bad luck Mick); Tom (15) gutsed it out and Adam made a good 39 before a tough fightback saw Kev Lynch (69 no) and Ben (18) put on 86 in 35 overs for the 9th wicket to see us all out for 184. Kev's gutsy batting should be a lesson to us all. STC has some new young talent with Ben and Peter Morrison both playing well in their first Semi.

It was disappointing to let ourselves and the Club down as these opportunities do not come readily. However, I was proud of the team's performances overall and it is pleasing that we have won the respect of our opponents. Congratulations to Mick Pivetta (395 runs; 25 wickets @ 18.0) for his fine season, the team trophy and bowling; to Kev Lynch (291 runs @ 48.5) for consistent batting all year and the trophy; and Pat Doch (375 runs @ 75.0). I thank Army, Kev and Pat for vice captaincy and their support in those tight ones. Well done also to Marty Lynch for his consistent bowling (28 wickets @ 24.0). It was a fine year.

A loss in my first game in round two was followed by two forfeits and a washout – which actually left us in a reasonable position. Our first on-field win came in round seven over Preshil (Jackson 4/39, Singh 55no.). This was followed by losses to East Doncaster - where we achieved a season-best 197 (Twaits 121) chasing their 297 - and Mont Albert.

After just one real win from the first nine games, we turned our season around with a big win in the return bout against East Doncaster in round ten. Rolling them for 107 (La Ragy 4/15), we got there for the loss of one wicket. The next game was a thriller. Defending 152 against St Stephens, we finally had them all out for 150, taking the last five wickets for 23 (Jondahl 5/28). Another win against the Deepdene Bears made it three in a row.

We then experienced a lull with a disappointing loss to Marcellin (a game which Tim Allen almost won on his own with 77 out of 106) and further losses to Heathmont and Preshil. This left us seventh, two games and percentage out of the four with three games to play.

Amazingly, after big wins against Deepdene (Nixon 57, La Ragy 4/9) and second-placed St Barnabas (Jackson 86, Singh 4/38) we began the final round in fifth place, only percentage out of the four. We won our last game, also against St Barnabas, quite easily (Twaits 4/20) and for a brief few minutes enjoyed fourth spot for the first time. But then a narrow victory by St Stephens over one of the lower sides condemned us to fifth, as we had failed to sufficiently narrow the percentage gap.

Obviously, when a side gets so close to the finals, it is very disappointing to miss out – particularly when we were playing our best cricket. But there were many positives to come out of the season. The team's ability to learn from the losses and bounce back was commendable, and underlined the character of the players. Most importantly it was an enjoyable team to play with.

We were arguably the best bowling and fielding side for the second half of the season. The leading wicket-taker was first-year player Terry La Ragy with 25, followed by Ranj Singh with 21 and Leigh Jondahl with 18. With the bat, I finished with 285 runs, with David Twaits on 244, and Brett Jackson on 227, while Ranj scored 224 to sew up a well-deserved Team Champion award.

On behalf of the team I'd like to thank the club for the support we've received in our debut season. Thanks also to the committee for their efforts in getting the side up and running. Special thanks must go to Ranj Singh, who did a terrific job as vice-captain this season. Lastly, I'd like to thank and congratulate the team on a great season. To go within percentage of making the finals was a magnificent achievement. We won more than half the points that were up for grabs for the season and finished in the top half of our draw – in most grades that will get you a finals berth. All in all this season was a great experience and it was a privilege to have been involved.
