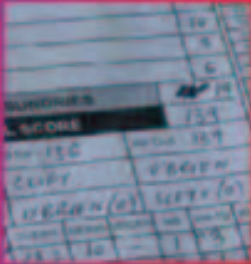

Presidents Report

Season 2004/5 was satisfying in many ways for me as President and for us as a Club but it was not without its disappointments and frustrations. I wish to highlight some of our successes, document some areas in need of attention by the incoming Committee and thank a number of people who have made substantial contributions this season.

I would like to thank Stephen Hoy for the assistance he gave me in his role as Senior Vice-President. Steve has provided abundant and well considered advice and has been unwavering in his support. The role of secretary was always going to be very difficult to fill but Nick Fennessy has performed admirably in the administration of the Club.

Stuart Hamilton, as Junior Vice-President, has been an outstanding addition to the committee and the success of our juniors this season is a credit to his hard work and commitment. Thanks also to Basil Finnigan for his untiring support of our junior cricket program.

The season had a number of social highlights and our financial success was due in no small part to profitable social functions. Kylie Zennaro did an outstanding job as Social Coordinator. Functions were well planned, well attended and memorable. Much of the social life of the Club is unstructured and takes place around the STC canteen. Daniel Sharpe has done an excellent job as canteen manager this year and deserves the appreciation of the entire Club.

I appreciate the work that Eddie Behan did as Treasurer and the work that Chris Classon did as acting Treasurer. The unfortunate events that forced Eddie to withdraw temporarily as Treasurer caused substantial disruption to our accounting and financial planning processes this season. The incoming committee will need to set in place contingencies to deal with unexpected absences of key committee members to ensure that a seamless handover to a deputy can take place. I appreciate the work that Eddie has done to piece together our financial statement for the annual report.

Again this season, we had outstanding support from sponsors thanks to the efforts of Craig Hynes. I extend my appreciation to all of our sponsors, especially our major sponsor, JA Cain First National. Unfortunately there were some misunderstandings and miscommunications between the Club and some sponsors and this must be addressed through more formal and structured sponsorship arrangements.

Too many people contribute to the work of the Club for me to possibly name them all. I appreciate the work done by all of our captains and vice-captains; our junior team managers; our senior players who supported junior training and games; our partners and spouses who enlivened games, social functions and match reports; our selectors who worked very hard every week to put teams on the field and ensure the best chance of on-field success; our juniors who filled gaps in senior sides; our members who attended working bees; and many others who simply saw jobs that needed doing and did them.

Over the years there have been many controversies surrounding the selection of captains, but the controversy about the selection of the third XI captaincy this year was the worst in my experience. I believe that there are many shortcomings in the process we have used to select captains including the fact that there is no documented process. In an attempt to address these inadequacies, I have drafted a paper outlining recommendations for a selection process which has been endorsed by the committee. These recommendations will be left to the incoming committee to implement.

The reputation of the Club has suffered in recent years as a result of a number of instances of inappropriate behaviour by a handful of our players. For me, the most frustrating part of my job has been

dealing with the Association, other Clubs and our own players about inappropriate behaviour. A good reputation is hard to earn but easy to lose. Rightly or wrongly, an outsider will judge our entire organization on the basis of a single interaction with a single individual. It is the responsibility of each and every Club member to uphold the reputation of the Club at all times both on and off the field.

The cricket risk assessment and management process initiated by the Boroondara Council two years ago remains unresolved. Uncertainty about ground allocation and/or reconfiguration has affected planning for our junior and senior cricket operations and refurbishment of facilities.

I was extremely impressed by the way members of the club handled the potentially divisive amalgamation issue at the beginning of this season. The spirit of our Club and our strong sense of Club history came through very clearly in our discussions. We may never know whether our decision was the right one, but once it had been made, we moved forward united, in the true spirit of STC.

This season, we did not enjoy the on-field success that we have experienced in recent years. Three senior sides made finals and our 1st and 6th XI ran second in Grand Finals. We remain a very large, talented and high spirited Club and will undoubtedly enjoy substantial success in years to come.

After four years on the committee, two as Vice-President and two as President, I plan to take a break from committee involvement. I will continue to be involved in the Club but I plan to take a less formal and less demanding role. As much as the job has been hard work and, at times extremely frustrating, I have enjoyed my involvement and, in particular, have enjoyed the friendship and support of Club members.

There are challenges ahead. However, the spirit of the STC Cricket Club is unmatched in my experience in amateur sport. If we continue to work together as we have in the past we will undoubtedly enjoy many years of social, financial and playing success.

Junior Co-Ordinators Report

The STC Juniors were a force to be reckoned with in the ECA junior competition for the 2004/2005 season.

The highlights of the year included:

- U12Blues were undefeated premiers of the RK Wilkins shield.
- U12Blues Angus Hamilton won the ECA batting average trophy for the shield.
- U12Blues Ben Robinson won the ECA bowling average trophy for the shield.

- U12Reds finished second in the ER Frampton shield by percentage.
- U12Reds Alex Ross won the ECA bowling average trophy for the shield.

- U10 Red and U10 Blues finish third in their respective shields.

- 5 boys from STC represented their schools at the VPSSA trials in March; Brendan Cain, Angus Hamilton, Simon Hearn, Tom Mitchell and Andrew Tan-Delli Cicchi. Simon Hearn made it through to the second stage of the trials.

- Angus Hamilton played in the ECA U12 Josh Browne plate side. The team were undefeated premiers.

- Andrew Krohn and Bevin Karunaratne played in the ECA U14 representative side. Andrew Krohn won the bowling average trophy for the team.

STC fielded seven teams in the ECA junior competition in 2004/2005: one U16, two U14, two U12 and this year, two U10.

STC continued to conduct a MILO Have A Go Clinic and this year the program had a 250 pct increase in numbers to 31 kids. We had kids from Prep through to Grade two so I quickly had to adopt a program that catered for the increase in numbers and the range of ages. I received great assistance from many of the parents and I must thank them all. The highlight of the year was when ten of the older kids were invited to play on the MCG during the tea break for the One day International Final between Australia and West Indies.

The U10's were managed by Andrew Jarrett and myself. Andrew had most of the first year players in the U10 Blues and after a few very close losses during the early games managed to come home with six wins in a row, finishing third on the ladder. The U10 Reds had a terrific season losing one, drawing one (to the eventual premiers) and winning 8 games to finish third on the ladder by one point. Both teams received fantastic support from the parents and I know this helps to make the Team Managers job a lot easier. With strong numbers coming through from MILO I expect that the U10's will have another great season in 2005/06.

The U12's were the stand out age group at STC this year. For the first time in STC history we had an U12 premiership team, the U12 Blues. The boys, and girls, had an undefeated season to easily take the premiership in the U12C RK Wilkins shield. Team Manger Roger Bluett, Coach Basil Finnigan and scorer Frank Delli-Cicchi should all be congratulated for a wonderful season. The U12 Reds under the management of Steve Ross also had a great season. They were unlucky when at the end of the season a corrected result relegated them to second place on the ladder on percentage only. They had beaten the premiers earlier in the season.

The U14 teams struggled to be competitive with numbers in both teams down. The U14 Reds, under Garry Terrill, and the U14 Blues, under Martin Lagastes, came close on a few games but each only managed one win for the season. A number of the players showed significant improvement through the year. Once again, the teams were supported by U12 players with Angus Hamilton playing in the U14 reds and Tom Beaton and Fabian D'Addazio playing in the U14 Blues.

The U16 team also struggled, ending with one win for the season. Paul Fiscaro took on the team manager role at short notice and after the Christmas break Peter Morrison took over. A number of the players were regulars in the Seniors and at Senior Presentation night Lawrence Colman was awarded Junior Legend status.

Basil Finnigan continued to travel up from Mt Martha three of four times a week. He was the coach for the entire Junior program. He also assisted with the victorious U12 Blues and the U16 team duties. A small number of other Senior club members assisted through the year but overall support from the Seniors was limited.

A number of Junior Social events took place through the year and all were well attended. There were four Wine and Cheese evenings held and I must thank James Hall from Camberwell Cellars for the wines and Peter McDonald from King Island Dairy for the cheese. The annual Parents and Kids game was also very well attended and we managed to run two games. In the U16/U14/U12 game the parents were successful and in the U10 game the kids were victorious.

I would like to thank all of the parents that helped through the year with scoring, umpiring, set up, canteen, transport, etc, etc, and of course for attending the various social events. The support had been greatly appreciated.

For the 2005/2006 I expect to have some initiatives in place to improve the coaching for the Juniors. With the assistance from more Senior players and more structure to the sessions I hope that we continue to enjoy the success of the U10 and U12 teams in 2004/2005 through all age groups.

After our breakthrough win last season, the club set out to try and win their first ever back to back 1st XI flag. Following a solid pre-season by most, the boys were extremely confident in making STC history.

Unfortunately our campaign started with a hiccup, losing our first game to a strong Trinity Willison outfit at our new home establishment, Howard Dawson. We proceeded to win our next 2 games, just scraping home on both occasions and then suffered a humiliating defeat at the hands of Burwood after having complete control of the game for the majority of the contest.

Following 2 scrappy wins and a disappointing loss to Burwood, the side had to have a look at themselves and their commitment. Round 5 saw us travel to Clifton Hill and comprehensively trounce them, with the side finally looking like they'd found some form. With no other side in the Macgibbon shield completing a game that round due to the inclement weather, the win was a massive boost and a definite turning point in the season. From here on in, the 1st XI would remain undefeated for the remainder of the home and away season setting up another final series.

Unfortunately as we all know, the final result that we were looking for did not eventuate but the side did not leave any stone unturned in trying to achieve our goal. In a season where we didn't achieve the ultimate glory the boys still managed to reach the grand final, working hard on both days, never giving in for a ball, and the club is no doubt proud of their efforts.

In a season where we only lost 3 games, individual performances were severely down on the previous three years, which funnily enough in hindsight, can probably be seen as a positive. With no hundreds, only 2 five wicket hauls and under 10 fifties scored, it only means there is more than enough room for improvement, and going by our performance this season there only needs to be a slight improvement to get us over the final hurdle.

With the possibility of change in the 1st XI due to extenuating circumstances, there is massive opportunity for many striving to play in the firsts. Having participated in 4 grand finals and winning 2 flags in recent times, it can be very easy for the side to become complacent and ponder on the past. It is a must that every player works twice as hard next season to make sure that the club is still moving forward, because at the end of the day the performance of the 1st XI is a reflection on the club.

In concluding I'd like to congratulate the other 5 captains for their work this season. In some circumstances our sides are competing against other clubs higher XI's, which is a very daunting task. A number of players made the step up from the 2's this season, which disrupted Craig's structure on many occasions, yet he would always put the welfare of the 1's ahead of the 2's, which is how a club stays so strong. Finally I would like

to thank the committee for the opportunity to captain such a great club, especially Tim Bach whose support and work went well beyond the clubs expectations.

Good luck to everyone in the coming season as we look to bounce back, and if recent history was to repeat itself, it will be our turn again next season!
