Basil Finnigan continued his work trying to turn our young cricketers into stars. A number of parents helped at U10 and U12 training but assistance from Senior players at these levels was disappointing. Senior players prefer to assist at U14 and U16 training. The improvement of the practice nets will enable more flexibility with junior training.

Thank you to all the parents that assisted as Team Managers, Scorers, Umpires, set up, canteen, transport, etc, etc. Their support is invaluable and greatly appreciated.

FIRST XI REPORT

After the disappointment of the last few finals series, this year the First XI was intent on turning our luck around and bringing home the Macgibbon Shield to its rightful home at Nettleton Park.

Our home and away performance was again fantastic with only one loss and one draw due to a washout. Our only loss for the season was a disappointing loss to Deepdene, our eventual grand final opponents however we regrouped and won the rest of our games for the season.

Our semi final was played at Swinburne against Trinity Willison, last year's Macgibbon Shield winners. After our best performance in the field for the season, we dismissed Trinity for 154, a total we thought would be within our reach. And confident we deserved to be as we chased down this total in the 34th over while only losing one wicket. This brought us to the grand final, with our opponents being Deepdene, who had made the last three grand finals. Of these they were unsuccessful in two and we were looking to make it three.

The grand final didn't get off to the start we wanted with the first day being a washout and the grand final being changed to a one day final. With some confident batting, we finished our innings on 6/209, a score we were positive we could defend. Alex King was fantastic as he played his best innings of the season with a match winning 81. Tom Bach was also very good opening the batting and seeing off the best of the bowling. After a slow start with the ball and some very ordinary fielding we stormed home taking plenty of wickets and at the end of their innings, Deepdene finished on 9/194 leaving us to claim the coveted Macgibbon shield.

We had four debutants for the First XI this season. Congratulations to Alex King, Angus Hamilton, Fabian D'addazio and Cam Fraser on making their debuts. Congratulations must also go to Alex King for his best on ground performance in the grand final winning the ECA player of the match and the Kevin Burt Medal, while also taking home the Best First Year Player award.

We had some individual highlights throughout the season. Tom Bach had a fantastic season with the bat, scoring 576 runs including a great knock of 159 and winning the Club Champion and batting awards. Overall for the season, we had two centuries and 16 half-centuries, which is a great improvement on our batting from last season, and a big factor in the success of the season.

Our bowling was also fantastic this year, with some standout performances from Ro Worthy, Luke D'Astoli, Dave Spithill, Daniel Fogarty and Adam D'Addazio. This season there were five 5-wicket hauls, which included two from Adam "Disco" D'Addazio who stepped up this season and looks to be a bowler of the future.

I'd like to thank Paul Zennaro and the rest of the committee for all of their hard work and support this season. As we all know, the club doesn't run itself and the committee do all of the hard work behind the scenes which allows us play cricket each week. It's fantastic that the team this season was able to reward these people with a First XI premiership.

I'd also like to thank my vice-captain Luke D'Astoli for all of his on-field and off-field leadership throughout the season. Luke did a great job of training and again he maintained all the on-line work that was required for the team.

And lastly I'd like to thank all of the players who played in the First XI this season; our hard work throughout the season was definitely worth it as we regained the Macgibbon Shield. But I put it to everyone don't be satisfied with last season, want more! The First XI has never won back-to-back premierships and now is a great opportunity to create more history! GO SAINTS!

After a strong pre season and solid performances in the first three rounds, he was promoted to the 2's. On debut, Fabian made 80 in a partnership that is now a club record for 7th wicket and in round 11 he made his debut in the First XI. As captain it was a joy watching talented young cricketers like Fabian, Loz Colman, Angus Hamilton and James Downie develop into fine cricketers.

There was also some very good cricket played by the more experienced players in our side – STC's unluckiest bowler Andy Class comes to mind. Like a fine red wine Class is getting better with age with no-one at our club beating the edge as often as he did this season. I would also like to single out the season of Julian Di Stefano. Jules is the most valuable player in the second XI and has been for a number of years. In 2008/09 Jules made 446 runs @ 31.86, always batting at the very top of the order, often after wicket keeping – an amazing effort. Congratulations to Julian on winning both the batting average and Team Champion awards.

Finally, I would like to thank all players that represented the Second XI this year especially Zed and Pete Lynch who came into the side in unusual circumstances in the final round of the season. These two guys performed sensationally and played an integral part in the second XI playing finals this year. I would also like to thank my brains trust that included Jules, Billy Hynes and Fizz. Their experienced advice and direction was fantastic and valued by myself greatly. I also wish to thank the committee for allowing me the privilege to captain the Second XI and most importantly congratulations and thanks must go to Stevie O'Connell for his ongoing support over the season.

In conclusion, in 2008/09 the Second XI went a long way towards winning the Burt Shield in 2009/10!
