

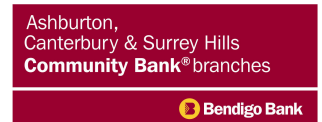
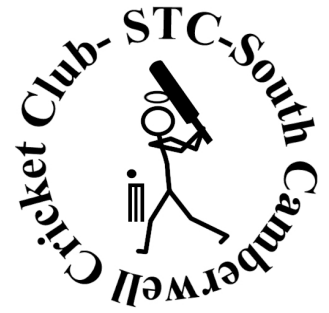

FIRST XI REPORT

After failing to make the finals last season for the first time in 9 years the 1st XI was extremely keen on making amends for the poor finish. We played a total of 19 games this season which included 6 twenty20 games in the ECA Primary Edge Cup. Of these 19 games the 1st XI lost only two and had one draw from a washout. So from these figures it's fair to say we definitely made amends for last season's poor showing. However in saying this, as good and consistent season we had, we still didn't manage to take home the Macgibbon Shield.

This season we started with five wins out of our first six games, which had us on top of the ladder going into Christmas, with only an unsuccessful run chase against Wyclif the blemish to our campaign. This loss would turn out to be our only loss for the home and away season. In total we played 12 home and away games with 10 wins, one loss and one washout. With all the rain that Melbourne endured this summer, the 1st XI played only two 2-day games for the entire season, as well as two draws from rain affected days. The lack of two-day cricket was unfortunately evident in our batting during the semi-final, where we collapsed to 5/39 and were unable to recover from this position, going down for only our second loss to eventual premiers Deepdene.

Although we didn't manage to achieve our goal of a premiership, we still had a successful season with many highlights and positives. The emergence of Beau Coyle as a 1st XI player was fantastic to see. Beau played the whole season in the 1st XI in both the Macgibbon shield and Twenty20 cup, and performed admirably with plenty of match winning performances, eventually leading to him winning the Most Improved Award.

Sam Fairbrother again had another fantastic Twenty20 season, with a Man of the Match performance in the Grand Final, and again taking out the Twenty20 Player of the Year Award. We look forward to Sammy taking his twenty20 form into the Macgibbon Shield next season. Another highlight worth mentioning was our 'come from behind' win against Trinity. With 5 overs left Trinity needed only 22 runs to win with seven wickets in hand. In the last five overs we took five wickets which included a hat trick from Luke D'Astoli and contained them to only another 13 runs, to record a memorable win.

As stated earlier we played six twenty20 games in the ECA Primary Edge cup. We won all six games and took home the cup in a great result for the club. These wins included the semi-final at Toorak Park against Ashburton Willows who went on to win the Dunstan Shield this season, as well as North Balwyn who we defeated in the tournament Grand Final and play in the Dunstan Shield also. The boys had a fantastic twenty20 tournament with some close and hard fought wins, including a bowl off win against last seasons' Dunstan Shield premiers Mont Albert. Taking home the twenty20 cup gives us another opportunity to play at the MCG next season, with the tournament winner taking part in the statewide competition.

I'd like to thank Dan Sharpe and the all the committee for their tireless efforts this season. The club cannot move forward without these volunteers giving up their time for the club and it is greatly appreciated. I'd also like to thank my vice-captain Luke D'Astoli who again did a fantastic job with his leadership both on and off the ground. Thanks also to all the players who played in the 1st XI, not the final result we were all hoping for, but a solid season nonetheless which can give us great cause for hope for next season.

Finally I'd like to thank the club. This is my final year as captain of this fantastic organization. It's been an awesome seven seasons, and a pleasure and honour to lead the 1st XI over this period. Change is exciting, and I'm sure it will be an exciting time as the 1st XI and club move into a new era. Thanks again.

SECOND XI REPORT

In the end, the 2nd XI finished the season in 5th place. Throughout the season there were some standout performances with both the bat and ball and a couple of inspiring wins. These are the things I'll focus on here.

In the beginning of the season the top order performed particularly well, with a couple of standout knocks. In the first game against BUCCC Daniel Sharpe made 76, while Jules Di Stefano, in the following match, compiled 69 runs against Trinity striking the ball with ease and power. In a hard fought game out at North Balwyn, Mick O'Connell (44) and Benny Banks-Smith (41) worked hard in trying conditions to give us a sniff. We narrowly lost that game to the eventual premiers. Fabian D'Addazio (32) and D Sharpe (97) compiled an excellent partnership to steer our team home against eventual grand finalists Deepdene. In the final game, where cool heads were required, D Sharpe (63) and Andy Krohn (40) stood up with the bat and again gave us a fighting chance against Trinity.

The bowling attack of the 2nd XI was one of the strongest in the grade. Loz Colman opened the bowling throughout the year finishing with an average of 8.6. More impressively was his economy rate of 1.9 from 92 overs. Taking 5/9 in the second round of the year and helping us to our first win kick-started Loz's season and he deservedly won the bowling average for Burt Shield. Our other regular bowlers – Dom Doyle, Matt Williams, Andy Krohn, and Mick O'Connell all put in strong performances throughout the year. Krohn picked up 4/20 against North Balwyn, while Matt Williams took his best bowling figures against BUCCC with 3/27. Mick O'Connell had a day out against Burwood taking 6/28, while Andrew Classon took 8/29 in two innings against Blackburn North United.

Classon's performance with the ball against Blackburn brings me to my favourite match and win of the season. We were at home and rolled Blackburn cheaply in the first innings for 97. As it happens, very early on the second Saturday the 2nd XI was bowled out for 92 – five runs short. This was Blackburn's first win for the year...or was it? I decided to send Blackburn in again. They 'deathed' for sometime but our bowlers were patient, testing, and accurate. We rolled them for 47 at exactly 5.31pm. We had 19 minutes to bat which equated to six overs and required 53 runs for victory. We scored seven from the first over and the task appeared great. However, we took over 30 runs from their next over, thanks to some powerful straight hitting by BBS. Classon smashed a 6 and Loz hit the winning runs with 4 balls to spare. Blackburn players were shattered and we were pumped. Never give up in a game of cricket.

Season 2011/12 holds much promise for STC's 2nd XI. It is an opportunity to build on the promising performances of the previous season and focus on developing consistency within and between games of cricket. I encourage all players to participate in pre-season cricket training, set some performance goals and work hard at achieving them throughout the year.

On a final note I want to again thank those who supported me in my role as captain of the 2nd XI. In particular I want to thank Jules, General, Sharpey, Brad, and BBS who provided invaluable advice and direction on game-day. Captaining was far more enjoyable for their input.

Finally, I want to thank the club for giving me the opportunity to captain an STC cricket team. Each time I took to the field with the team under my charge and wearing the red cap, I did so with pride.
